\$1,200 will create and support a match for 1 year



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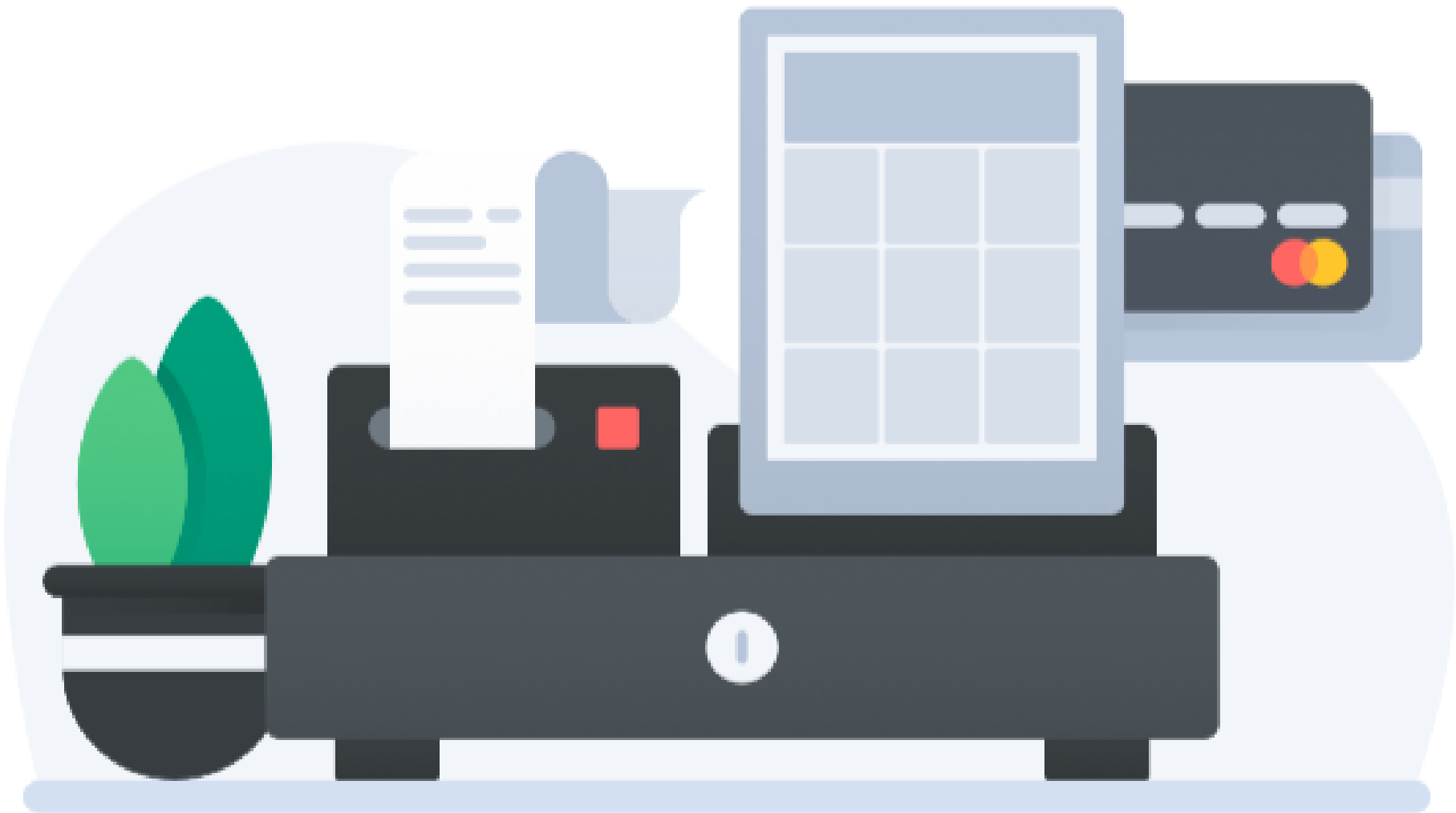

WHAT PROGRAMS WILL BENEFIT FROM E.I.T.C?



PURPOSE:

The EITC Program was established by the Department of Community and Economic Development that awards tax credits to businesses that make contributions to an approved educational improvement organization.

APPROVED BUSINESSES HAVE 2 OPTIONS:

- Two year agreement - 90% credit up to a maximum of \$300,000 per year.
- One year agreement - 75% credit up to a maximum of \$200,000

ELIGIBILITY:

Businesses authorized to do business in Pennsylvania who are subject to one or more of the following taxes:

- Corporate Net Income
- Capital Stock Franchise
- Bank & Trust Company Shares
- Title Insurance Companies
- Insurance Companies Shares
- Insurance Premiums
- Mutual Thrift Institution
- Personal Income Tax of S corporation shareholders or Partnerships partners

BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS' HIGH SCHOOL "BIGS" PROGRAM

Trained high school students serve as "Big" Brothers or Sisters to elementary school students referred by guidance counselors or teachers. "Bigs" and "Littles" meet weekly at the elementary school. High school students receive leadership education and experience and the value of community service. The younger student benefits from a role model who is willing to talk, listen, and engage the child in activities in a supervised setting.

HIGH SCHOOL BIGS MATCHES SERVED

- 89% of volunteers reported an increase in client's self-confidence
- 79% of volunteers reported improvement in client's relationships with peers
- 74% of volunteers reported clients improved in their ability to make decisions
- 65% of volunteers reported client's ability to avoid substance abuse
- 64% of volunteers reported improvement in client's family relationships.
